

Error Description	Example	Log Error Message
Omitting a Required Semicolon	<code>proc print data=pilotdata</code>	Syntax error, expecting one of the following...
Inserting Unnecessary Semicolons	<code>input EmployeeID \$1-6; Firstname \$7-19; run;</code>	Statement is not valid or it is used out of proper order.
Inserting Unnecessary Equal Sign in the Data Statement	<code>data=pilotdata;</code>	Statement is not valid or it is used out of proper order.
Omitting a Required Equal Sign When Identifying a Data Set in a Proc Statement	<code>proc print data pilotdata;</code>	Expecting an =.
Failing to Use a Dollar sign to Identify a Character Variable	<code>input EmployeeID 1-6;</code>	Invalid data for EmployeeID
Misspelling a Word	<code>data pilotdata; : : proc print data=pilotdate;</code>	File WORK.PILOTDATE.DATA does not exist
Misspelling a Keyword	<code>date pilotdata;</code>	Assuming the symbol DATA was misspelled as date.
Typing the Letter O When You Meant To Type A Zero	<code>Lastname \$2O-34</code>	Expecting a name. Missing numeric suffix on a numbered variable list (O-NAME)
Omitting Required Quotation Marks	<code>title 'Management Report ;</code>	The TITLE statement is ambiguous due to invalid options or unquoted text
Omitting The Run Statement	<code>proc print data=pilotdata;</code>	No error message, but no output appears in the output window until the next proc step is submitted
