## What's Changed Between the 7.x Releases?

#### QUESTION:

On page 2-48 of the course PDF [SAS Enterprise Guide for Experienced SAS Programmers] **and** on page 2-22 of the course PDF [SAS Enterprise Guide 1: Querying and Reporting] the Challenge level exercise "Browsing a data set in the data grid" refers to HIDE and HOLD functionalities of the EG Data Grid. These options are missing in my Enterprise Guide. When was this functionality removed?

#### ANSWER:

SAS Enterprise Guide 7.12 does not have the Hold/Hide features in the data grid. The data viewer was completely revamped and includes some new things like Zoom and Copy with Headers, but it lost a few capabilities as well.

#### QUESTION:

[In SAS Enterprise Guide for Experienced SAS Programmers] when following the "Combining Results" demonstration, the PDF does not display correctly. The final report contains black boxes where the graphs and figures are supposed to be. Also noticed is that the report header does not display. What are the reasons for this?

#### ANSWER:

For the banner image, instead of adding using the Header & Footer settings, use Insert Image when placing the objects on the report. This will cause the graphic to be embedded in the resulting report.

- Support for SAS Visual Analytics 7.4.
- New Catalog and Formats Explorer is available.
- New option that enables you to create accessible PDFs.
- The ability to open script files in the text editor.

## SAS Enterprise Guide 7.13

- New DATA Step Debugger is available.
- New Copy Files task is available.
- The ability to upload SAS 9.4 data to Cloud Analytic Services (CAS).
- Changes to the default graph format; the default is now PNG.
- You can specify a username and email address to use when you commit your program changes.
- You can specify how to handle an error during the execution of an item in your project or process flow.
- General enhancements:
  - You can scroll horizontally in the data grid, program editor, and process flow by pressing SHIFT + mouse scroll wheel.
  - You can set the zoom percentage back to 100% by pressing CTRL + 0.
  - Server file navigation on Microsoft Windows servers now defaults to your Documents folder and contains folder shortcuts.
  - You can now change the label of any data node.
  - There are several accessibility improvements and new keyboard shortcuts. The JAWS screen reader can now read the label on the projects tree, and all areas of the user interface are accessible when navigating backwards by using SHIFT+TAB.

- The save functionality has been updated to include a new Save All (CTRL + SHIFT + S) option.
- You can generate results in a Microsoft Excel format and a Microsoft PowerPoint format.
- General enhancements:
  - You can zoom the contents of items in the workspace, such as programs, data, HTML results, and process flows.
  - You can open externally referenced files in their default associated applications. For example, when you open a Microsoft Excel file from within your SAS Enterprise Guide project, the file opens in Microsoft Excel.
  - You can open the file location of externally referenced files in Microsoft Windows Explorer.

## SAS Enterprise Guide 7.11

- You can quickly filter data with a WHERE expression. You can create a WHERE expression for data that resides on the server or for the local data provider.
- General enhancements:
  - You can check for software updates.
  - After you create a prompt, you can copy and paste it within the same project or into another SAS Enterprise Guide project.
  - Data and reports can now be added to your list of favorites.
    - You can specify the locale of the workspace server session by using the Server session locale option.
